PURPOSE OF MEETING: The City of Portland seeks to balance the increased demand for mobile wireless services while providing timely and adequate prior notification. This pre-application informational neighborhood meeting is solely intended to provide information to interested parties and to allow such parties to provide comments, information regarding the project and proposed aesthetic and design options for the company to consider. Per City of Portland Administrative Rule UTL-3.07.

PROPOSAL: T-Mobile proposes to install an unmanned telecommunication facility consisting of the replacement of an existing 66'4" PGE pole with a 79' utility pole. There will be 6 panel antennas installed along with 6 remote radio units and 2 hybrid cables. No equipment will be installed on the ground adjacent to the tower, but instead will be located in the newly developed building to the North of the PGE Pole.

PROPOSED TIMELINE: Timeline depends on site development processes including permitting and lease completion. T-Mobile anticipates construction commencement in the 3rd quarter of 2021 with estimated completion during the 4th quarter of 2021.
